

DNHG Visit to Manarat Al Saadiyat Museum, Abu Dhabi
17 May 2014

A visit to the Manarat Al Saadiyat Museum in Abu Dhabi has been arranged for DNHG members on Saturday 17th May 2014.

The exhibition's title is "The History of the world in 100 objects". These objects have been taken from the British Museum and span 2 million years of the history of the world.

After viewing the exhibition we can enjoy a light snack/early lunch at the museum's Fanr restaurant and then head back home by 13:00 - 13:30p.m.

Maximum number 30 people.

Transport to the museum has been organised. The Bellobus Company will be providing the transport. Cost per person, providing we have at least 25 people, will be Dh60/-.

Bus pick up point will be as follows:

The bus will be parked opposite JESS where the cars are parked.

Directions to the bus pick up point for trip to Abu Dhabi Manarat al Saadiyat trip on
Saturday 17th May 2014

Coming from Sheikh Zayed Road take Safa Park turnoff into Al Hadiqa Street (Street 69). Safa Park will be on your right. Take the first 'U' turn to the left. Do not go straight across into Street 6 but take the next turning to the right which is Street 12A. Pass by the Medcare Hospital on your right and, at the 't' junction, turn left into 7th Street. Jumeirah English Speaking Primary School will be on your right and opposite the school is a large parking area where you can leave your car.

If you are coming from Abu Dhabi direction along Al Wasl Road go through the traffic lights by Park and Shop and take the next turning to the right which is before the Al Wasl Square shopping complex into 7th Street. Then continue straight along the road to JESS school.

If coming from Dubai on Al Wasl Road you will go straight through the traffic lights with HSBC on your right and then turn left at the next set of traffic lights (Union Coop will be on your right) into Al Hadiqa Street. Take the second turning on the right into Street 12A and then left into 7th Street.
